Be a part of Go Green Wilmette's own
SkyDay Project with your sky photos!

SkyDay (skydayproject.org) is an international art project to increase people's awareness of our shared atmosphere and its fragile condition. SkyDay takes pictures of the sky from anywhere in the world and creates an ever-changing mosaic from them that's connected to facts and resources about the sky. SkyDay has already appeared at the Shedd Aquarium, the Chicago Botanic Garden and even on the International Space Station!

Between now and March 10, 2019, Go Green Wilmette is collecting as many photos of the sky as possible from New Trier and other communities to create our own SkyDay mosaic. We need your help! Submit photos (take only the sky; no other objects or the horizon) using the instructions below, and we will include them in our own mosaic that we'll display at our March 10 environmental fair in Wilmette.

It's easy! Here's how:

Take a digital photo of the sky

Go to: <http://skydayproject.org/>

Click: "upload photos"

Select a group: select "Go Green Wilmette"

Under "Where are you": select the country in which the photo was taken

Click: "browse" to locate your image on your phone or computer

Click: "Submit"
