Canyonlands Wilderness Canoe Trip ~ New Trier Summer School Course July 8-20, 2019



<u>Course Description:</u> On this 13-day course, students will study the ecology, geology, and history of the Canyonlands of Utah while completing a 120-mile canoe trip. This wilderness experience will allow each student to develop a knowledge and appreciation of their environs while developing skills necessary for successful individual and small-group travel in a rugged wilderness region. Additionally, the trip includes two days of hiking in scenic Arches National Park.

Eligible students: All rising Soph, Jr, and Sr students of NTHS. No wilderness experience necessary. Trip is limited to 12.

<u>Instructors:</u> Co-leaders: David Goodspeed (NT retired Science teacher) and Elizabeth Plank (current Social Studies teacher). We are both experienced (20+years) teachers, advisers and coaches. There will be a third adult guide. The 2019 trip will be our 11th NT summer school wilderness trip.

soon as possible, if there's an application extension).

Early Feb. Group participants will be selected and all applicants will be contacted through their advisor.

3/1/19 Full tuition DUE to Ms. Plank. (This is, at most, 50% refundable in case of cancellation)

6/12/19 Informational meeting for participating students and parents 7pm Rm. 104 Winnetka Campus. Mandatory attendance.

Completed medical and safety forms will be collected at this meeting. Agenda will also include: meeting teachers and group leaders, student code of conduct, detailed trip itinerary, logistics, equipment lists, and distribution of pre-trip

readings.

NT before departing for Utah the next morning.

Full tuition (\$1900) includes: travel expenses, food on the canoe trip, group equipment (tents, cooking equipment, camping gear, safety and first aid equipment).
