Teacher then registers with code provided in confirmation email, creates Mastering course which will generate a Course ID. Refunds available if there is a reported issue with the iBook.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Add bookmark(s), highlight text and take notes ● Sync progress across devices ● Adjust font size, text, and background color ● Read books in a continuous vertical scroll ● Print notes via AirPrinter ● Have book read aloud through Accessibility Features ● Embedded interactive media elements & hyperlinks to additional resources ● Look up word definitions in multiple languages
