RUVNA Screening Update

- Incorporating latest IDPH guidance
- Participation in high-risk sports



Shield Illinois Testing Update

- District is in contact with Shield Illinois, the testing group established by the U of I
- Currently conducting 1-3% of tests in the nation
- Saliva-based test, administered on-site with same day results
- Results sent to parents, school, and Cook County Health Department
- Determining if we can establish a regular on-campus testing plan for staff and students
- Evaluating legal issues (voluntary vs. mandatory)
- Program may be online in November
- Not a replacement for infection control and mitigation efforts (masks, social distancing, hand washing)

Metrics - Operational

- Feedback to Chairs/Coordinators about issues with spaces or facility adaptation
- Ad Hoc committee developing mask wearing guidance and rules
- Building level committees for monitoring / problem solving (leadership teams)
- >1 month supply of PPE
- Surveys
