

Freshman Adventure Program FAQ

1. What are the dates of the program?

- The 2019 trip will run from June 17th- 20th .

2. How many students go on the trip?

- In the past we usually take about 40 students/year. Our maximum capacity for the program is 45 students.

3. How many kids are in each camp group?

- Our groups consist of up to 12 students, 2 teachers, and up to 2 senior helpers.

4. Where do the kids sleep?

- The kids will sleep in tents provided by the school. There will be separate tents for girls and boys.

5. What about bathrooms, showers, etc?

- The campground has bathrooms with running hot water. Individual shower rooms are available for student use.

6. How much does the trip cost? What does the cost include?

- The total cost of the trip is \$225.00. That includes all meals, gear, and a T-shirt.

7. Is there financial assistance if needed?

8. What if my child takes medication?

- Each child is responsible for their own medication on the trip. The teachers will remind students to take their medication but will not distribute it.
