

Welcome to New Trier Class of 2027 Incoming Freshman FAQ

When will I meet my adviser?

You should have received your adviser assignment in mid-July. The first gathering of your adviser room will be on the first day of school on Monday, August 21st. If you did not receive a letter from your adviser and senior helper please contact Laurae Nielsen at nielsenl@nths.net.

When will I get my class schedule?

You should have received an email with information on how to access your student's schedule and booklist from Principal Paul Waechtler last week. General back to school information will be accessible on the New Trier Website.

What if I have not completed my residency verification?

You can access the verification forms in Power School. If you have questions about how to complete this verification, please contact the registrar at registrar@nths.net. You must complete your enrollment to receive your student's schedule and booklist.

Should I buy my school supplies before school starts?

There is no school supply list for 9th grade. Individual teachers will tell you what you need for class during the first few days of school. You will need a mix of binders, folders and notebooks. **All students will receive a free Trevian tracker school planner in adviser room.** Calculator information can be found on the New Trier Website.

How can I purchase my books?

The bookstore will be open at the *Winnetka Campus August 1 through August 16th (8:00 am-3:30 pm)*. Online sales are also available until **August 14th**. Click here for the <u>New Trier Book Store</u>. The bookstore will be closed on August 17th and 18th. The Northfield Bookstore will be open August 21st during lunch periods from 11:00 am-1:45 pm.

When can I get my school ID?

Your adviser will have your ID for you on the first day of school if you have taken your picture. If you did not have your ID picture taken during iPad orientation, you can take it in the first days of school during your study hall.

How can I make sure that my iPad is ready for the beginning of school?

Where can I find information about summer reading?

Go to the <u>English Summer Reading</u> page on our website. Summer reading books are different for each class level. Your class level is the **last digit of your English course number.** Follow the directions for each specific class. Teachers will expect the reading to be completed for the first day of school.

Where do I submit my forms to participate in athletics?

Where do I go on the first day of school and what do I bring?

Every student should report to adviser room at 8:00 am on the first day of school. Freshman orientation will take place with your adviser room before classes begin. Academic classes will be 15 minutes long and school will be dismissed at 1:20 pm. Please see this link for the opening day schedule. Your adviser will give you a copy of your schedule and assign you a locker. You do NOT need a lock for your school locker. You do not need to bring your books on the first day of school. A folder, a notebook, your iPad and a pencil are sufficient.

What do I need for my Kinetic Wellness class?

You will need a kinetic wellness uniform and a lock for your kinetic wellness locker. Both of these items can be purchased at the school bookstore. You do not need your kinetic wellness uniform on the first day of school. Please see the <u>Dance Webpage</u> for information on Dance attire.

How do I buy lunch in the cafeteria?

You can pay for lunch with your student ID. You should have received an email from New Trier with your verification code and directions to add funds to your student account. Deposits will be made through Revtrak. If you have questions, please contact Pia Fazio of Quest Food Services at faziop@newtrier.k12.il.usThe cafeteria will also accept cash payment. New Trier will provide a small grab and go lunch during periods 5A and 5B for all freshmen students on the first day of school.
