**Welcome to New Trier High School!** Through our Mobile Learning Program (MLP), New Trier is committed to integrating mobile technology into our classrooms in meaningful and transformative ways. The iPad offers a unique set of features that create opportunities for:

- individualized learning,
- increased student engagement, and
- the potential to transform teaching and learning.

All New Trier students are required to have a New Trier-issued iPad to access tools used daily in their classes. The District partially subsidizes this purchase, which includes an iPad, wireless keyboard, durable case, and AppleCare protection. **Beginning on May 4th**, you can go to the [MLP Portal](#) and get started by:

- Locating the “**My iPad Selection**” button along the left (browser) or on top (mobile)
  - Enter your student’s last name
  - Enter your Student ID number
- Making your iPad selection by choosing one of these options:
  - Purchase iPad - \$350.00 per child.
  - iPad Loan Program for families in need of financial assistance. For more information visit the [financial assistance page](#) and begin the application process. Families will need to have financial assistance approval to pick up an iPad on their scheduled distribution day.
- Signing up for a mandatory iPad pick-up day and time. Due to social distancing policies, iPads will be distributed on the date you select, and instructions will be provided to complete the setup/orientation remotely.

**Please remember:**

- Please complete your iPad purchase and select a pickup time **before June 15th, 2021**.
- At your pickup date, bring a photo ID and proof of purchase (such as a printout receipt or email on your mobile device).
- Students will have the opportunity to have their ID picture taken during their iPad pick up time.
