

NIGHT LEAGUE RULES

Sportsmanship

The Booster Club runs Night League to help promote school spirit, healthy competition and collegiality among New Trier students. No foul language or unnecessary rough play will be tolerated. Referees and volunteers are to be treated with respect. They have the authority to remove players and/or entire teams from the game at any time. The New Trier Athletic Code of Conduct will be strictly enforced.

Game Time

Referees keep the game clock. All games will have two 15-20 minute halves and a 2 minute halftime. Exact game time length will be based on how quickly we can turn over courts between games. The last 2 minutes of the game is "stop-time", meaning the clock will not stop for fouls, ball out of bounds, violations, etc.

Scoring

All baskets are worth 2 points and free throws are worth 1 point. Check with the referee each game to see if 3 point shots allowed (will be at their discretion based on court size). New this year: **Home teams, as indicated on the schedule, are responsible for keeping score.** This can be done by designating a player or bringing a volunteer (ie. parent or friend) or asking the NL coordinators for help.

Tie Game

At the end of regulation, teams play 2 minutes of "stop-time" overtime. At the end of overtime, the first team to score wins, aka "sudden-death".

Players

1. Teams must have at least 5 players to play the game. If a team has less than 5 players, they forfeit the game unless (see #2)
2. Both teams can agree to play 4 v 4 if they chose to. If neither team has at least 4 players, both teams will receive a "loss"
3. Un-rostered subs are allowed as long as the player is a NT student. The sub must not be rostered on ANY other Night League team or NT interscholastic basketball team.
4. Additionally, both teams must agree to allow the sub to participate BEFORE the start of the game. Once the game is played, there will not be any disqualifications.
5. NL Coordinators reserve the right to do a roster check on any team at any time
6. Absolutely no subs will be allowed during play-offs. If you do use a sub during playoffs, your team will automatically receive a "loss". Playoffs start on 1/24/24

Forfeit

If you know you need to forfeit, please be sure to text the captain of the other team as well as the appropriate Night League coordinator listed below at least 1 hour before game time. If you do not have the other team's captain information, text the NL coordinator listed below.

Score Sheets

Team captains (or a rostered player if captain is absent) and referees will sign the score sheet after the game. Make sure that the score, court #, team names and date are correct. A signature represents approval of the details listed.

Referees

Referees have the final word and will resolve all disputes.
