New Trier's first semester is set to end on **Thursday**, **December 22**, before Winter Break. This email includes information about the end of semester schedule, including:

- Final Exams in Math and Science on December 19 and 20
- Other End of Semester Assessments
- Early Dismissal Anchor Day on Thursday, December 22

Final Exams in Math and Science on December 19 and 20

Students will take 90-minute exams in their Math and Science classes on Monday, December 19, and Tuesday, December 20. Times are assigned by course:

- Northfield Campus Exam Schedule
- Winnetka Campus Exam Schedule

Note that **exams at both campuses begin at** <u>8 a.m.</u> This is earlier than a typical school day on the Winnetka Campus. Students need to be on campus only for their assigned exams. Students with exam accommodations will receive instructions regarding those accommodations.

Other End of Semester Assessments

The Modern and Classical Languages Department will hold Language Performance Assessments in class during the week of Dec. 12-16. Other courses may have culminating papers or assessments in class that week as well.

If students have more than two assessments, major papers, projects or longer-term assignments due on the same day, they should email/message their teachers (copy adviser and case manager, if applicable), and those teachers will collaborate to determine which class will postpone their due date for one day. Students may also reach out to their advisers for assistance in notifying their teachers if needed.

Early Dismissal Anchor Day on Thursday, December 22

New Trier students will not attend school on Wednesday, December 21, which is a Staff Institute Day. On Thursday, December 22, they will attend all classes for an early dismissal Anchor Day to wrap up the semester and receive their first semester grades:

Please note that this is a change from the original school year calendar, which had students attending for a full day on December 22.

Winter Break begins on Friday, December 23, and classes resume on Monday, January 9.
