Jan Borja dedicated her professional career to the students, staff, and community of New Trier High School. She worked here for 40 years as a teacher, adviser, adviser chair, department chair and principal. She served as the principal of the Northfield Campus when it reopened as a freshman campus in 2001. She retired in 2011. She will long be remembered at New Trier, especially for her focus on the whole child.
