

2022-2023 Advanced Placement (AP) Registration Information

For Students enrolled in one or multiple AP courses

AP Exam Registration is a Two Step Process:

Step 1: Student must join AP Classroom Online & enter unique Join Code

During the first weeks of school, all students registered for at least one AP course during the 2022-2023 school year will be provided a unique AP Join Code for each AP course they are taking. The AP join code will be provided by the AP teacher of each subject. Students must create an AP Student Account and enter the AP join code for each subject in order to indicate their commitment to take the AP exam by Friday, **November 11, 2022**.

Once you have selected to register, the date and time of your exam will appear in your course card in the AP student account.

Step 2: Paying for AP Exams

- The 2023 AP exam fee is \$97 per exam if the join code is entered by Friday, November 11, 2022.
- All exam fees will be placed directly in your account that is accessible through the [PowerSchool Parent Portal](#) after the student enters the AP join code for each subject.
- All exam fees must be paid in full no later than March 1, 2023
- **Late Fees (per College Board)**
 - There will be a non-refundable \$40 late fee for each exam registered after the November 11, 2022 deadline.
 - There will be a \$40 fee for any canceled exam after the November 11, 2022 deadline.
 - If the \$97 was previously paid, the difference will be reimbursed via PowerSchool.
