#### **GENERAL**

<u>Abbott & Fenner Business Consultants</u> offer a scholarship of up to \$1,000 each year to the winner of their essay (500-1000 words) contest question: "Describe your educational career and life goals. Explain your plan for achieving these goals. Include your degree/major, why you selected it, and how this degree/major will help you achieve your goals." <u>AES Engineers</u> is offering a \$500 award to students, regardless of their field of study.
