Welcome to the adviser program at New Trier High School. The Adviser is an important communication link between school and home, as well as an effective advocate for your child. We hope that you and your student will take full advantage of the support that the Adviser Program can provide during freshman year and throughout high school. There will be 36 adviser rooms at the Northfield Campus of approximately 25 students each. Adviser room will meet daily from 8:00 a.m. to 8:25 a.m. Your student's adviser is listed above.

The second name(s) listed above is your child's Senior Helper. These student leaders provide additional support in the freshman adviser rooms by serving as older peer role models and assist in making your student's transition to high school as smooth as possible. Senior Helpers will be working with your child's adviser room two days a week. In mid-July, you will receive a letter of introduction from your Adviser and Senior Helper(s) containing details about your group's adviser room party to be held the week before school begins. This event will provide the opportunity to meet the other students in the Adviser room and bring the group together prior to the first day of school. Senior Helpers will be arranging tours of the campus during this time.

Once the year is underway, you will meet your adviser on Freshman Adviser Parent Nights. The Girls' Adviser Rooms will meet on September 2nd and Boys' Adviser Rooms will meet September 1st at 7:00pm. Individual Parent/Adviser conferences will be scheduled at a later date for you to provide any relevant information that will assist us in supporting your student.
