

Grants Funded by the NTFAA for the 2022-23 School Year

1st Semester

- Art: Grants for visiting artists in ceramics (Raku workshop with Carl Mankert), glass (advanced glass technique with John Miller), and sculpture (felted figuration for stop motion animation with Kiyoshi Mino).
- Dance: Grants for 10 visiting dancers to work with all dance levels in a variety of styles including HipHop, Modern, Korean, Salsa and West African dance. One grant to support the Dance Lab 1 and 2 showcase.
- Debate: Grant to support the Trevian Invitational Debate Tournament.
- Theatre: Grant for artist Nina Lynn to work with students to create large scale puppets for the stage.
- Music: Grants to support college audition workshop, choral master class (with Julio Morales and Sherryl Sewepagaham), and the New York Symphony and Chamber Orchestra Tours.

2nd Semester

- Art: Grant for visiting artist, Dylan Cooper, a renowned graffiti artist, to work with NT Art students to create an enduring mural at the school.
- Theatre: Grants for providing master classes in Kabuki Theatre with expert George Keating and Improvisation with No Questions Asked Improv Club, as well as support for the Improv Club Showcase Evening. Also provided a grant for the Technical Theatre and Design Class for a master class in Sewing and Costuming with Emily Daugherty.
- Music: Grants for master classes taught by visiting artists, David Binder, a New Trier Alum and Professional Trombonist with the Detroit Symphony Orchestra and Nadje Noordhuis, a trumpeter with a national Jazz Orchestra and teacher at the Berklee College of Music.
