

Grants Funded by the New Trier Fine Arts Association for the 2021-22 School Year

1st Semester

- Art: Grants for visiting artists across the disciplines of painting and drawing (Aya Nakamura and Nicole Gordon) and pottery (Raku firing workshop with Carl Mankert).
- Dance: Grants for 10 visiting artists to work with all dance classes across a variety of styles of dance, including Salsa, West African, Chinese, Hip Hop, Voguing and Modern. Many guest artists directly align with New Trier's goals in equity diversity, inclusion and social emotional learning.
- **Debate:** Grant for visiting debate research expert who will help coach and guide students and instruct them on highly technical research skills.
- **Music:** Grants for band clinicians to work in person with each of the four wind ensembles; Grant for New Trier JazzFest featuring the Ulysees Owen Jr. Big Band.
- **Theatre:** Grant for workshop in which students will learn stage combat skills. This curriculum will tie into the Winter Play (Cyrano) and the Spring Play (Moon Over Buffalo).

2nd Semester

- Art: Grants for additional funding for exhibit and gallery talk with Nicole Gordon, New Trier alum and local painter, and for Raku workshop
- **Dance:** Grant for enhanced costumes and marketing materials for Dance Lab Showcase; Grant for new Dance Division summer dance camps for students ages 4 through rising 9th grade.
- Music: Grant for Elmhurst University Concert Band Festival.
- **Theatre:** Grant for Kabuki master class by George Keating, DePaul University; Grant for improv master classes and performances with ComedySportz Chicago; Grant for hand and machine sewing unit with professional costume designer, Emily Daugherty.
